



Thank you for considering Gloucester County Habitat for Humanity ReStore for your charitable donation! Please note that the IRS requires your donation to be in "good used condition or better." This is the standard we will use in determining whether to accept the donation. Our Donation Criteria is a general guide for donors. All donations must be in good used condition or better. Acceptable items are subject to frequent change. Legal restrictions and limited storage capacity prevent the acceptance of some items.

All items MUST BE clean and in good working condition.

Appliances

Accepts all appliances – must be cleaned/wiped off prior to pickup

Cabinets/Countertops

Only complete cabinets, less than 20 years old, with all doors attached and drawers

We do not accept cabinet doors or drawers by themselves

Must be free of rot and in usable condition

Doors

Must be in good condition, free of holes

Must not have rot, cracks, or separating

We do not accept shower doors

Electrical Fixtures/Lighting

Accept electrical parts, lights, wire and hardware associated with electrical wiring

Light fixtures must be in working order

Must be clean and not covered with rust

No fluorescent lights or bulbs

Entertainment

Accept radio/stereo systems (must not be older than 5 years)

Accept TV's (must not be older than 7 years)

Accept game systems, DVD's

Flooring

Only *new* carpet and linoleum will be accepted

Hardwood flooring must be in excellent condition and nail free

Furniture

Must be clean: No stains or odors.

All furniture must be free of rips and tears

Must be vacuumed before pickup

Must be in overall good condition & need no repair

Hardware

Accepts hardware for doors, cabinets, etc.

Must be in good condition and not rusty

Must be separated by type/style

Home Décor

Must be cleaned and not broken.
All mirrors must be framed.

Landscape Materials

New patio and paving stones
Patio furniture

Lumber / Plywood / Siding / Trim

Accept full and 1/2 sheets of plywood
Accept full lengths of lumber (8 ft)
All scraps must be 4 feet or longer (8 feet for pickup)
Trim accepted in smaller pieces
Must be free of rot, nails, and screws
Accept new, full boxes of siding only (must be enough to complete a project: shed, garage, etc)

Plumbing Fixtures

Should be clean and in usable condition
Fixtures, sinks, tubs, showers, vanities and medicine cabinets.
We do NOT accept toilets

Roofing

Shingles must be in complete packages (must be enough to complete a project: shed, garage, etc)
Metal roofing in full lengths, if possible
Most roofing material donations are accepted on a case-by-case basis
Occasionally we are overstocked on roofing items. Please call ahead to make sure we are accepting roofing at the time of your donation

Tile

Accept vinyl and ceramic tile, unused or clean
Accept tile as long as there are at least three full boxes
(must be enough to complete at least a small project; bathroom, hallway, etc)

Windows

Prefer windows 10 years old or newer*
No cracked or missing windowpanes
No single paned windows
Include all window hardware if appropriate
Window sashes required

Some items we DO NOT ACCEPT:

suitcases/luggage
entertainment centers
sewing machines
baby items
mattresses
clothing
